





Have a clear commitment to challenging and supporting leaders






Regularly review your own performance and contribution

Discovery MAT takes very seriously its responsibilities to safeguard children in our schools. The appointment process requires newly appointed LAB members to undergo a DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) check within 3 weeks of appointment. Refusual to comply leads to disqualification as an LAB member. We will also follow up your references and ask you to produce evidence of identity (e.g. a passport or photo driving licence prior to your first meeting).
