New Dinner Menu

What does low or poor attendance look like?

In every school year there are 190 school days and 175 non-school days.

96% attendance means your child has missed seven and a half days of school in a year.

95% attendance means your child has missed nine and a half days of school in a year.

90% attendance is a morning or afternoon missed every week.

85% attendance means your child has missed twenty eight days (a month) of a school year.

92% attendance over your child's whole school career (5 to 16) is equivalent to missing a whole year, of school.

At Discovery Multi Academy Trust, the expected level of attendance is 96% or above. In an unusual year, or due to unusual medical circumstances, a child's attendance may drop below this.
