Sports Day, Friday 7th June – 11.45am

One of the most exciting events of the Summer Term, Sports Day, is fast approaching! The children have been preparing during their PE and Outdoor Games lessons and we would like to invite you to come along and support the children with lots of enthusiasm and your loudest cheers! This year, the children will be taking part in a carousel of activities during the morning and then competing in individual races in the afternoon.

Weston Mill Community Primary Academy would like to invite you to have lunch on the field with your child/children starting at 11.45am. The children's races will begin at 12.45pm. If you would like to order your child a school packed lunch for this day could you please return the reply slip below by **Friday 24th May**. The school dining room will only be providing a range of packed lunch options so everyone can eat outside, there will be no hot dinners on offer for this day. If the letter is not returned we will assume that your child will be eating lunch provided by yourselves.

In the event of poor weather and cancellation you will be notified by text message at the earliest opportunity. A reserve date is provisionally booked for Wednesday 12th June.

In anticipation of hot, sunny weather (fingers crossed!), please ensure that your child brings a water bottle and a sunhat for the day. If you wish your child to wear sunscreen please ensure that this is applied before they come to school.

Throughout the day the children will be competing in their house teams so we ask that you provide your child with a plain t-shirt (no football tops) in their house team colour (Plym – green, Tavy – yellow, Tamar – red, Lyner – blue). If your child is unsure of their house please speak to their class teacher. They should also wear shorts or tracksuit bottoms and be wearing trainers not plimsoles. Please send your child into school wearing their PE kit on sports day. **All pupils will need this kit in school during the whole week 3rd June – 7th June as they will be participating in a range of sports activities.**

The afternoon races are timetabled to start at 12.50pm. There will be a clear section for parents/carers/grandparents etc to sit in where you can watch all of the races. The children will be sat in year groups with members of staff. To ensure the children's safety it is imperative to remember that under no circumstances should you come over and remove your child from their group. We also ask that you do not try to give them any refreshments during the afternoon races; we will make sure their water bottles are refilled. When the races are finished all children must go back to their classes and you will be able to collect your child at the end of the day as normal.

We look forward to seeing you at our School Games Day to support the children as they participate in this fun and enjoyable event. Don't forget to wear your trainers so you can join in the parent races!
